

Mathematics

Number and Place Value

- Count to / across 100.
- Count in 1s, 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Identify 'one more' and 'one less'.
- Read & write numbers to 20.
- Know number bonds to 20.

Calculations and Problem Solving

- Add and subtract one-digit and two-digit numbers to 20, including zero.
- Use +, -, and = symbols.

Measures

- Use common vocabulary for comparison, e.g. heavier, taller, full, longest, quickest.
- Begin to measure length (standard and nonstandard).
- Sequence events in chronological order using time words.

Geometry and Shapes

- Describe position on movement.
- Recognise & name common 2-D shapes.

Fractions

- Find and name 1/2 as one of two equal parts.

Faith and Belief

Thanking God for Nature

- Explore the Biblical Creation Story.
- Learn about Harvest Festivals (Christianity), Sukkot (Judaism).
- Understand how to care of the natural world (Islam).

Light

- Explore the symbolic meaning of light. Choose from, for example: Advent, Christingle (Christianity), Diwali (Hinduism), Hannukah (Judaism).

Christmas

- Understand how light is used in the celebration of Christmas.

Citizenship and Ethics

- Follow classroom rules and expectations.
- Strategies to deal with arguments and disputes.
- Talk about likes and dislikes.
- Talk about feelings, i.e. what makes me sad and why.
- Talk how to look after myself; cleaning, appearance.
- Respond to question of the week.
- Participate in Philosophy for Children.

Literacy, Language and Oracy

Reading

- Match graphemes for all phonemes.
- Read accurately by blending sounds.
- Read words with very common suffixes.
- Read contractions & understand purpose.
- Read phonics books aloud.
- Link reading to own experiences.
- Join in with predictable phrases.
- Discuss significance of title & events.
- Make simple predictions.
- Name the letters of the alphabet.

Phonics

- Revise all sounds.
- Read and spell tricky words.
- Blend and segment words.
- Read and write words beginning with clusters.

Writing

- Spell tricky words.
- Spell days of the week.
- Compose sentences orally before writing.
- Read own writing to peers or teachers.
- Story writing- focus: predictable phrasing.
- Write reports.
- Write labels, lists and captions.
- Write instructions.
- Use phonics as the prime approach for spelling.

Grammar

- Use finger spaces.
- Use capital letters and fullstops.
- Use capital letters for proper nouns.
- Use pro-nouns, nouns, proper nouns.
- Use Verbs.

Speaking & Listening

- Listen & respond appropriately.
- Ask relevant questions.
- Maintain attention & participate.

Handwriting

- Follow Term one PenPals.
- Form capital letters.
- Form lower case letters correctly.

Physical and Emotional Health

Activities

- Explore different movements (run, jump, throw, catch, balance...)
- Travel in different ways
- Develop agility and co-ordination
- Develop spatial awareness
- Use apparatus

Personal

- Talk about how to be healthy (eating and being active)

Art and Creativity

Art

- Create self-portraits using different media.
- Explore the work of Picasso.

D&T

- Safety when using kitchen utensils.
- Sample different fruits from around the world, explore senses.
- Design and make a healthy soup.

Music

- Sing songs
- Play tuned & untuned instruments musically.
- Listen to and appreciate live and recorded music
- Make and combine sounds musically

Science and Technology

ICT

- Understand and use algorithms
- Write and test symbol programs

Biology

- Identify and name basic body parts
- Identify and compare common animals
- Identify basic plant parts
- Compare human/plant anatomies

French

- Use greetings (hello, goodbye, how are you?, Merry Christmas).
- Count to 20.
- Name members of the family (Mum, Dad, Brother, Sister, Grandma, Grandad).
- Name pets.
- Name basic body parts (head, shoulders, knees and toes).
- Listen to traditional French tales

Geography Skills

- Talk about where I live and places I like to visit
- Read maps
- Make a survey of the local high street
- Describe the local area of St.Albans, name key places

Historical skills

- Notice how St. Albans has changed through time
- Describe similarities and differences between now and then
- Find out about bonfire night
