Year 4 Ancient Egyptian Experience Day – Tuesday 13th June 2017

Year 4 will be taking part in an ancient Egyptian experience day as part of our topic work this term. The day will include a fascinating session, delivered by experienced staff from St Albans Museum, where children will investigate a variety of real and replica artefacts which will enable them to explore key aspects of the ancient Egyptians' way of life. This will include how they wrote, what the children played and how they treated the bodies of those that had died.

To add to the enjoyment of the day, we would also like the children to come to school dressed as an Egyptian. Examples of this could be: a white t-shirt and white shorts, a white tunic with a rope belt, or white dress.

The day will be taking place in school so children will order their school dinner or bring a packed lunch as normal and the day will end at the normal time of 3.30pm. There is a charge to cover the cost of the Museum Service visit so we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £3.00 per child.
