Online Payment via Website:

For those opting not to use childcare vouchers or Tax-Free Childcare, payments can be made directly through our website. Alternatively, if you wish to make payment using childcare vouchers or Tax-Free Childcare, please do select this option at checkout.

After enrolling in your chosen classes, you will be directed to the payment section of the website where you can securely pay via debit or credit card.

CCTS Terms and Conditions

1. Booking and Payment

A child's place is only confirmed once payment has been received, either via invoice or through our online booking system.

All fees must be paid in full prior to the start of term. If payment has not been received before the start of term, CCTS reserves the right to refuse attendance at the first class and any subsequent classes until the outstanding balance has been settled.

Failure to make payment by the required date, following reminders from CCTS, may result in an administration fee being added to your balance.

2. Late Payment

If fees remain unpaid after the term has begun and following several email reminders, a late payment fee of 2% per week will be applied to the outstanding balance for each week the fees remain unpaid.

3. Missed Sessions, Cancellations and Force Majeure

Regrettably, we are unable to offer refunds for any sessions missed due to illness, holidays, personal circumstances, or any other reason where your child is unable to attend.

Force Majeure refers to circumstances beyond the reasonable control of CCTS which prevent or affect the delivery of classes. This may include, but is not limited to, host school or venue closures, venue unavailability, emergency closures, adverse weather, fire, flood, utility failures, public health emergencies, government restrictions, or other unforeseen events.

Where a class is unable to take place due to a Force Majeure event, including a cancellation or closure by a host school or venue, CCTS will not normally provide a refund, credit, or replacement session.

CCTS will, however, consider reasonable alternatives where possible, including rescheduling, online delivery, or other arrangements. Any alternative offered will be at the discretion of CCTS.

CCTS will endeavour to provide notice as soon as reasonably possible where a class is affected by a Force Majeure event.

4. Term Commitment

Once your child's place has been booked and paid for, that place is reserved exclusively for them for the duration of the term. We are therefore unable to offer refunds where you choose to withdraw your child after booking, as the place has been allocated and staffing and venue arrangements have been made based on the booking.

Refunds are not available for trial sessions.

By enrolling your child with CCTS, you are committing to the full term and are therefore liable for the full term's fees.

5. Behaviour and Conduct

CCTS reserves the right to remove a child from a class if their behaviour is persistently disruptive, prevents others from participating fully, or poses a risk to themselves, other children, staff, or the safe running of the class.

In such cases, any refund or credit will be at the discretion of CCTS.

6. Class Changes

CCTS reserves the right to make reasonable changes to class times, venues, teachers, or class arrangements when necessary.

We will always provide as much notice as possible and ensure that any changes do not affect the overall quality of our provision.

7. Photography and Media Consent

Photos or videos may occasionally be taken during classes for promotional purposes, including our website, social media, or printed materials.

If you do not wish your child to be included, please let us know in writing.

8. Acceptance of Terms and Conditions

By booking a place with CCTS, you confirm that you have read, understood, and agreed to these Terms and Conditions.

These Terms and Conditions apply to all bookings made with CCTS and form part of the agreement between CCTS and the parent or guardian responsible for the booking.

Expected Costs at CCTS

At CCTS, we are committed to keeping our training accessible and affordable, while still providing a high-quality experience for every child. Below is an outline of expected costs across the academic year, to help families plan in advance:

Term 1 – Uniform Guidance

To support high standards of technique and confidence in class, we encourage a simple and practical uniform for all students.

Uniform requirements include:

- CCTS Theatre School T-shirt
- Black leggings, joggers or tracksuit bottoms
- Black trainers, black plimsolls, or black jazz shoes

Please note: Only the CCTS branded t-shirt must be purchased directly from our uniform shop. All other items may be sourced from high street retailers, as long as they meet the requirements.

For students trying out our club or those unsure about continuing for future terms, there is no pressure to purchase the full uniform straight away. Plain black alternatives are perfectly acceptable.

Term 2 – Show Fee (Optional)

Students who choose to take part in our end-of-term production will be asked to pay a £25 show fee.

This fee contributes towards:

- Venue hire
- Additional staffing for rehearsals
- Administration and production costs

Participation in the show is entirely optional. Children are very welcome to continue attending our weekly drama classes even if they choose not to take part in the performance.

Term 3 – Costume and Show Ticket Costs

Costumes:

- Costume costs will vary depending on the role and production, but we always aim to keep these to a minimum.
- Wherever possible, we ask families to provide basic items from home to reduce or eliminate costume charges.
- Where costumes are supplied, they are yours to keep after the performance.

Tickets:

- Tickets for our Big Summer Show at The Radlett Centre will be available to purchase closer to the date.
- Families will also have the option to buy a digital download of the performance as a keepsake.
