Netball at ACS

Year 6 team compete in an Autumn and Spring league, as well as a tournament in the Spring term.

The team is chosen by Mrs Wonnacott at her discretion, all children will have the chance to represent the school in some capacity.

Year 6 have training on a Wednesday every week come rain or shine for two terms.

The training is to support the team in competitive fixtures and impacts the selection of children (good attitude is a non negotiable).

X-Country at ACS

Year 6 team (12, 6 boys & 6 girls) compete in a league format where the top 4 finishers scores are used to compete in a team and individual league format.

Children have already had a chance to try out x-country and children who have been chosen will be told today. (Resilience is KEY)

Girls Football at ACS

Year 6 team compete in both league, cup and tournaments throughout the year (Year 4 & 5 both can play but Year 6's are prioritised).

Football selection

24/25

All Year 6's who want to play will be given the opportunity to represent the school at a SUITABLE level.

The boys and girls teams are entered into competitive leagues and cups (A teams only), the selection for the teams represents this, all fixtures need to be completed by March so these teams take priority. Friendly games and fixtures will be organised in the summer term to offer a suitable environment for any other children wishing to represent school.

Football selection

24/25

All Year 6's who want to play will be given the opportunity to represent the school at a SUITABLE level.

Clubs will be used for the most part to select children to represent each team unless communicated otherwise e.g. clash with external paid club

Fixtures will sometimes be scheduled when an afterschool club is but will be avoided if possible.

Detrimental behaviour could mean children being unavailable for selection if used as an appropriate consequence.

Cricket at ACS

Year 6 team compete in a league format with top team in each league going through to a finals day.

Clubs in summer term will be used to determine selection.
