Music

Every Tuesday Year 3 learn the recorder with Miss Sazanova (recorders are provided by the school). Please encourage your child to practise their recorder at home.

On Wednesday afternoon the classes will be taught by Mr Clements and Mr Bushell.

Homework will be set on Friday using Google Classroom. Please let us know if you would prefer to receive the homework on paper.

Reading is a vital part of the Homework we set. We will be asking to see the reading records and the expectation is that there is a minimum of 3 comments every week. Diaries will be checked once a week.

Spellings are set weekly and tested every Friday.

Times Tables Times Table Rockstars is a good way to support your child learn their times table facts. We have seen rapid progress when children access TTRS at least 3 times per week.

How you can help at home:

- Listen to your child read at least 3 times a week.
- Ask questions about what they have read (Who? What? When? Why? How?).
- Encourage your child to practise their weekly spellings.
- Practise the 2, 5, 10, 3, 4 and 8 times tables using TTRS.
